REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY, JULY 8, 2013

CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the Bowie City Council was held on Monday, July 8, 2013 in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG:

Mayor Robinson led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

QUORUM:

In attendance were Mayor Robinson, Mayor Pro Tem Polangin, Councilmembers Brady, Gardner (arrived 8:10p.m.), Marcos, Truth and Turner; City Manager Deutsch, Assistant City Manager Fitzwater, City Clerk Hernandez and the Public.

PRESENTATIONS:

A. Mayor Robinson made a motion to approve Proclamation P-16-13 – Commemorating 60th Anniversary of the Korean War Cease-Fire. Councilmember Turner seconded the motion and it carried 6-0.

Mayor Robinson presented the proclamation to Mr. William Alli and thanked him and his colleagues for their years of service in the military.

COUNCIL ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mayor Robinson thanked staff and the Bowie Baysox on behalf of Council for the extraordinary 4th of July celebration.

CITY MANAGER'S REPORT:

City Manager Deutsch stated that staff will be holding a wrap-up meeting in reference to the event held at the stadium and will brief Council at a future meeting.

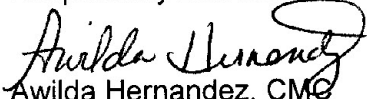

D) Approval of Resolution R-49-13 – Waiving the Competitive Bidding Requirements of Section 61 “Purchasing and Contracting” of the Charter of the City of Bowie by a Two-Thirds Vote to Allow for the Rental of Leaf Collection Trucks and Authorizing the City Manager to Enter Into a Contract with Hertz Equipment Rental in the Amount of \$50,280. Councilmember Brady seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
