Status Report

1. Network Support

The expanded complexity and use of the City voice/data network has created a need for regular and continued support. The FY13 Budget includes funds for this support including weekly visits to analyze log files and server activity, regular security audits and penetration testing. Columbia Telecommunications Corporation (certified MBE/WBE) has been providing network support via a purchase order in FY11 and 12. The hourly rate offered is via a COG rider on Montgomery County contract #4346000017AA Amendment No. 7. They have proposed a total price not to exceed \$50K. As provided in Section 62 of the City Charter, this will serve as the required seven-day notice of intent to purchase network engineering support from Columbia Telecommunications Corporation.

2. County Council Legislation Results

Yesterday, the Prince George's County Council voted on two (2) County bills recommended for approval by the City:

CB-87-2012 - County Recycling Program. Motion to approve by Council Member Olson, seconded by Council Member Lehman, passed unanimously. The Chairman of the City's Environmental Advisory Committee and two (2) members of a nonprofit advocacy organization spoke in favor of the bill at the public hearing.

CB-110-2012 - Health Clubs in the M-A-C (Major Activity Center) Zone. Motion to approve by Council Member Turner, seconded by Council Member Davis, passed unanimously. The bill becomes effective in 45 days and will expand leasing opportunities at Bowie Town Center.
