1. County Executive's Commission for Education Excellence Holds Meeting

On Tuesday, January 22, the County Executive's Commission for Education Excellence held a special meeting with the Prince George's County Board of Education at the South Bowie Library. Tuesday's meeting was the first time the two groups have met together. Both County Executive Rushern L. Baker, III and Prince George's County Board of Education Chair Verjeana Jacobs spoke. County Executive Baker told everyone that the purpose of meeting was to affirm that everyone is working together on the charge to show that the County is making strides in education. Ms. Jacobs said the Board of Education is committed to the partnership with the Commission. Dr. Charlene Dukes, the President of the Maryland State Board of Education, presented a report on School Progress Index that included information on County schools. The Commission for Education Excellence is a 12-person volunteer advisory committee formed by the County Executive to provide advice on various education-related matters.
