SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY, APRIL 14, 2014

CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The Special Meeting of the Bowie City Council was held on Monday, April 14, 2014 in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG:

Mayor Robinson led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

QUORUM:

In attendance were Mayor Robinson, Mayor Pro Tem Trouth, Councilmembers Brady, Gardner, Polangin, and Turner; City Manager Deutsch, Assistant City Manager Fitzwater, City Clerk Hernandez, Staff, and the Public.

AGENDA ADDITIONS/DELETIONS/AMENDMENTS:

Mayor Robinson added Item B under New Business – Reconsideration of Amber Ridge Zoning Map Amendment Request presented during the April 7, 2014 Regular City Council meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Introduction of Ordinance O-3-14 – Approving and Adopting a Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2014 and Ending June 30, 2015 and Resolution R-17-14 – Adopting a Capital Improvements Program for the Fiscal Years 2015-2020.

Public Hearing:

1. Andres Kolaja, 3757 Bedford Drive, North Beach, spoke in support of the proposed two-sheet ice arena in the City.
2. Joseph Loschiavo, 3403 Blandford Way, Davidsonville, is in support of the two-sheet ice arena.
3. Bill Schmidt, 12414 Sarah Lane, spoke in support of two-sheet ice arena to be able to support more hockey games and practice time.

Since there were no more speakers signed up to speak, Mayor Robinson declared the public hearing to have been held.

Councilmembers thanked residents for their input and staff for their efforts in putting together the budget.

Mayor Pro Tem Polangin made a motion to Introduce Ordinance O-2-13 – Approving and Adopting a Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2014 and Ending June 30, 2015. Councilmember Truth seconded the motion and it carried unanimously 7-0.

Mayor Pro Tem Polangin made a motion to Introduce Resolution R-26-13 – Adopting a Capital Improvements Program for the Fiscal Years 2014-2019. Councilmember Marcos seconded the motion and it carried unanimously 7-0.

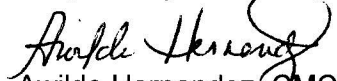
Mayor Robinson thanked the Commission members for their presentation.

Councilmember Gardner seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-1 (Brady).
