Status Report

1. Old Town Bowie Stakeholders Meeting

On Tuesday, October 5th, the Planning Department conducted a Stakeholders Meeting regarding a proposed four lot residential subdivision of the Hayden Property (Preliminary Plan #4-21027). The 2.4-acre property, located at 12705 10th Street and Zug Road, is currently occupied by Ray's Towing and a single-family detached home. Two people attend the virtual meeting. The proposed subdivision plan will be scheduled for a City Council public hearing in the next several months. A video of the meeting has been placed on the City's Youtube channel.

2. Economic Development Committee (EDC)

The EDC met Wednesday at the Bowie Business Innovation Center on the campus of Bowie State University. University President Dr. Aminta Breaux spoke to the group. There are 6,708 students enrolled – the majority are undergraduates, and approximately 972 are graduate students. Dr. Breaux said her vision for the University is that it is a place to Stop, Study, Learn, and Work. The next regular meeting of the EDC is November 10, 2021.
