A. City Council Legislative Priorities – City Council discussed their 2024 Legislative Priorities (list attached).

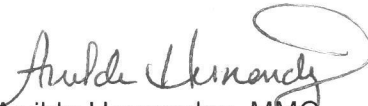
Councilmember Gardner motioned to accept the 2024 Budget Priorities. Councilmember Truesdale seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.
