### **STATUS REPORT**

**1. Temporary Pavement Markings**

The Public Works Department has identified a Contract for temporary pavement markings services with the State of Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration (Contract No: 479D51426) through Traffic Lines, Inc., upon which we will be able to piggyback. We will sign a Contract and issue a Purchase Order to Traffic Lines, Inc. in the amount of \$99,900.00.

As provided in Section 62 of the City Charter, this will serve as the required seven (7) day notice of intent to purchase.

**2. Economic Development Committee (EDC)**

The City's EDC met Wednesday and continued their discussion and work on the reenvisioning of the 'Town Center'. They are specifically looking at the commercial properties from the former Regal Cinema through the former Sears. The EDC is preparing for a bus tour of selected current development projects in the Washington-Baltimore region to see first-hand some examples of dense mixed-use. The next EDC reenvisioning work group meeting is July 14. The next regular EDC meeting is July 9.
