Adoption of Ordinance O-10-25 - Amending Chapter 17, "Park Rules and Regulations," Section 17-5, "Enforcement; Violations and Penalties," To Provide That It Is a Misdemeanor to Camp in City Parks or to Remain in City Parks After Closing in Violation of Section 17-2, "Park Rules"; and Amending Chapter 22, "Streets and Sidewalks," Article I, "In General," Section 22-11, "Buildings or Obstructions in Streets, Sidewalks, or Alleys Unlawful," To Clarify That the Erection of Tents and Other Shelters in the Public Right of Way Is Prohibited, and Amending Section 22-19A, "Enforcement; Violations and Penalties," To Declare That the Erection and Maintenance of Tents or Other Shelters on Public Property to Be a Misdemeanor and to Prescribe a Penalty for Said Offense **(PH/EFA - Police Dept., ext. 5700)**
