STATUS REPORT

1. FY26 Electronics Recycling Events

The Public Works Department (PWD) has scheduled for FY26 four (4) electronics recycling events at the Public Works Solid Waste/Recycling Building Parking Lot, 16500 Annapolis Road, Bowie, MD, from 8am-2pm on:

Saturday, June 27, 2026

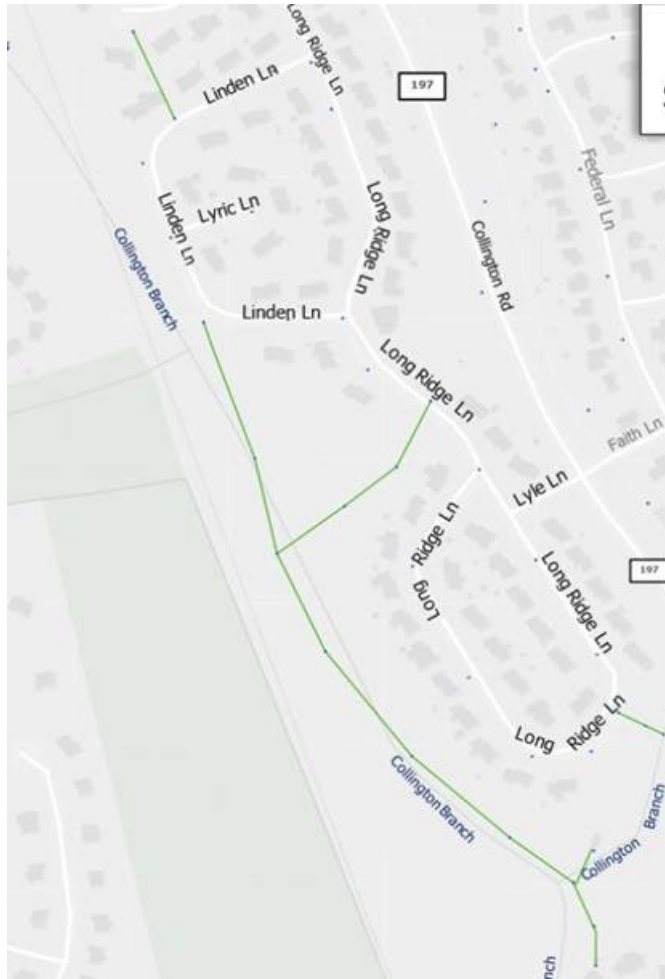
Residents can bring their electronics for recycling at no charge. See the attached list of acceptable items. Please note that hard drives will not be shredded on-site.

2. Sewer Main Inspections – Long Ridge

The City of Bowie has contracted with Riviera Enterprises to clean and inspect, via closed circuit television, 121,000 linear feet of large trunk and right-of-way sewer mains. The purpose of this work is to clean these sewer mains and verify the condition of the pipe. Riviera is scheduled to start work in the Long Ridge neighborhood on Monday, October 13, 2025. Due to the extent of the work, it is expected that Riviera will be in the Long Ridge neighborhood for approximately two (2) weeks.

Work will be performed Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., excluding the City-recognized holidays. While the work will require equipment in the street, no road closures are expected to be required.
